In August, 1994 the second Woodstock Music Festival was held in Saugerties. The Woodstock '94 Celebration Committee will be acknowledging the 30th anniversary of this amazing event with an August, 2024 month long, multi venue observance. The Saugerties Chamber of Commerce is writing you this letter to ask for a donation to keep the sprit of Woodstock '94 alive in our community

Plans for "Celebrate 30" include a kick off celebration at Cantine Field featuring live music, food vendors and arts and crafts, live music at The Partition and other Saugerties venues, displays of photos and videos of Woodstock '94 attendees. The culmination of "Celebrate 30" will be the Hope Rocks Festival. There are even more events in the planning stages.

The Saugerties Chamber of Commerce 2024 Street Art theme—"Groovin' Around Saugerties" has been chosen to honor "Celebrate 30". 35 artist painted "hippie buses" will be parked on the streets of the town and village of Saugerties from Memorial Day weekend up to and including Labor Day weekend. There will be an online and in person auction in September. Proceeds of this auction will benefit the participating artists, the Saugerties Chamber (which uses the money to help support community causes and events), a local not for profit organization and a scholarship to a graduating Saugerties High School student.
